### **Calstock Higher Kelly Lane**

**Est. time up to 90 mins (ca. 1.6 miles)** Lovely walk along footpaths and through wooded areas. Option to stop for refreshments in village afterwards.

9th October

# Up and Around Hingston Down

Est. time up to 2 hours (ca. 2.93 miles)
A walk along public footpaths up to
Hingston Down with stunning views
from the heathland across to Plymouth
Sound. After reaching the Down, we
take the lane back to the main road,
before taking a footpath and country
roads back to Albaston. Some steps
and a small stream crossing, so
appropriate footwear needed.

16th October

# Harrowbarrow Coombe and Prince of Wales Mine

Est. 75 mins (ca.2.4 miles)

A scenic walk along public footpaths, quiet roads and through Mining Heritage land. This is a Circular walk with a couple of steady uphill and downhill descents. Three kissing gates. Can be muddy at times so good walking footwear recommended.

23th October

## St Germans Circular (New walk)

Est: 90 mins+

Walk to St Germans quay, then up into fields (moderate climb), views everywhere, returning to village via the Stableyard cafe as seen in Beyond Paradise with the option to stop for coffee or return straight through Port Eliot estate to car, passing St Germans Priory, open for visitors!

30th October

## **Weir Quay**

Est. 75 mins (ca.2.1 miles)

A very scenic route starting along the Tamar riverbank with uninterrupted views of the water and then climbing to enjoy fantastic views of the Tamar Valley. This walk requires greater effort as a third of the walk is a long, steep uphill climb. Using country lanes and public footpaths. Mostly good walking surfaces but uneven in places and can be very wet underfoot. No stiles. Good boots essential.

6th November

## To Calstock via Danescombe Valley

Est: 90 mins (ca.2.3 miles)

This is a fantastic walk through the Danescombe Valley ending in Calstock. On footpaths this walk does include some small downhill sections, including a steep field that can be slippery. Stiles and steps and a narrow path along the stream bank that can be very wet. Please bring bus fare or pass for return to Centre on 79/79A bus.

13th November

#### **Tavistock Canal**

Est: 2 hours (ca.4.3 miles)

A walk and return along the old towpath tracing the canals route from where the water is taken from the Tavy to Shillamill Viaduct, where the old railway line crosses the canal. A beautiful flat walk often with lovely reflections in the canal water.

20th November

## **Kit Hill Quarry Circular**

Est: 90 mins (ca.1.9 miles)

Another great Tamar Valley walk on Kit Hill Country Park and Local Nature Reserve. We will follow the road uphill for a short way, then take the path on the right-hand side to the quarry, after which we make our way on rough paths and well-maintained paths back to our starting point. There is the chance to go up to the stack, to enjoy the amazing 360° views from the top of the hill.

27th November

#### **Bere Ferrers to Thorn Point**

Est: 2 hours (ca.2.9 miles)

One not to be missed! Stunning views in a wonderful setting. Some road walking, mainly along public footpaths and the Discovery Trail. Long steady climb towards end.

4th December

# Middlemoor Circular (New walk)

Est: 2 hours (ca.3.5 miles)

A varied walk on the edge of Dartmoor National Park with moorland, footpaths and a very old drovers lane as part of the route. Strong shoes or boots needed.

11th December

# Bere Alston Station to Tuckermarsh Quay

Est: 2 hours (ca.2.8 miles)

An attractive route, mainly on public footpaths, through lovely deciduous woodland down to the river Tamar with daffodils in the spring. Very muddy and uneven in places, potentially slippery following rain. Crossing two small shallow streams. Uphill section from river back up to Bere Alston Station is long and steep but we go at an easy pace.

18th December

#### **Norris Green/Honicombe**

Est: 90 mins (ca.2.6 miles)

This walk is solely on byroads and country lanes, passing through Albaston and Norris Green. A few ups and downs, and although all on road, we pass through some beautiful countryside and treelined roads.
